"This year's global campaign for World Day Against Trafficking in Persons urges accelerated action to end child trafficking. Children represent a significant proportion of trafficking victims worldwide, with girls being disproportionately affected.

A staggering 1 in 3 victims of human trafficking globally are children.

Additionally, children are twice as likely to face violence during trafficking than adults, according to the [Global Report on Trafficking in Persons](#). Regions such as Sub-Saharan Africa, North Africa, and Latin America and the Caribbean bear a disproportionate burden, with children making up for 60 percent of detected trafficking victims."
