## Sample Reflection, Prayers for Pilgrimage of Hope 2025



## A. Reflection at a site of Ecological Destruction

The world is charged with the grandeur of God. *Love* loves us into being. We belong to and in God's creation. This sacred belonging calls us to care for the Earth—as a core expression of our faith.

When our relationships with creation, each other, and God are broken, all suffer. Environmental harm today impacts human health, intensifies natural disasters, and impedes our witness to the Gospel—especially our call to stand with and serve those who are made poor by our global 'diseconomy'.

As Pope Francis teaches in *Laudato Si'*, environmental degradation disproportionately affects the vulnerable. This is our Gospel call. But awareness of the Church's teaching in this area remains limited. Just one in ten Catholics says they truly understand what environmental justice means, and most have never encountered *Laudato Si'*. This *Jubilee Year of Hope* and *the tenth anniversary* of Laudato Si' is a time of both opportunity and urgency.

We can and must work and pray to repair and restore our relationship with God through the healing of our relationship with creation. This work is not separate from our spirituality—it is essential *to it*.

This is why we are joining **Pilgrimages of Hope for Creation**. In these journeys, we embrace the earth not only physically, but also in spirit. We grieve the pollution and devastation. We walk together—with *LOVE*, with creation, and with one another—renewing, reconciling, and sharing responsibly. People of all ages, races and identities express together our faith-in-action.

- 4. That our leaders in Church, SSND and society may teach and apply Pope Francis' themes in *Laudato Si*', to protect the environment, promote justice for marginalized communities, and foster a culture of care for God's creation. *We pray to You Love... Love, hear our prayer*.
- 5. For those who are most affected by the destruction of creation, particularly Indigenous communities and those on the frontlines of climate change, that *Love* may empower us to listen and *hear* their voices, feel compassion, address their needs, and seek justice for all of creation. *We pray to You Love... Love, hear our prayer*.
- 6. For the healing of the earth, that through our prayer, reflection, and action during Pilgrimages of Hope for Creation and beyond, we may retore ecosystems, protect

biodiversity, and use natural resources responsibly as God passionately desires. *We pray to You Love.*.. *Love, hear our prayer*.

- 7. That those who feel disconnected from nature or lack access to the beauty of God's creation, may experience the healing power of nature and increase their awareness of God's presence in all things. *We pray to You Love.*.. *Love, hear our prayer*.
- 8. In this tenth Anniversary Year of Laudato Si', that all people may collaborate to give future generations the gift of Earth with cleaner land, water, and air . . .healed, restored, and teeming with life. *We pray to You Love.*.. *Love, hear our prayer*.
- 9. Inspired by St Francis of Assisi in this 800th year anniversary of his Canticle of the Creatures, that we may safeguard biodiversity, protect and restore even the smallest of the species, for not one of them is forgotten in God's sight.

#### D. Sample Reflective Walk in Residence's Outdoor Areas
