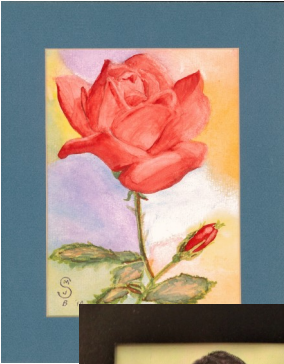


Sister Mary Jane Buhrman SSND - 70 Year Jubilee!
