

Historic, past and current moves of Sisters to a new home:

Villa Maria (Notch Cliff), Baltimore, MD – November 4, 1983, Move of Sisters to Villa Assumpta to consolidate two health care facilities that were operating undercapacity into one at Villa Assumpta, Baltimore, MD.

Chicago, IL – Move of Sisters to Resurrection Life Center in February 1998. In 1999 the Academy of Our Lady closed. In August of 2005 the Sisters moved to Marian Village.

Embracing the Future:

- Relocating Sisters in need of skilled nursing care at Villa Notre Dame (VND) to Ozanam, NY 09/2019
- Closing of Lourdes Health Care at VND 12/2019
- Closing of Notre Dame Convent Cemetery 01/2020; transfer of deceased sisters to Gate of Heaven Cemetery, Burlington, ON 07 – 08/2020
- Consolidating sisters at Notre Dame Convent from 4 floors to 2 floors in 2021.
- Selling of Notre Dame Convent on May 30, 2022 to Laureate College, a private college prep high school. However, Sisters remain living on two floors.
- Relocating Sisters from Villa Notre Dame (VND) to Watermark/3030 Park in Bridgeport, CT (08/2021).
- Seeking to sell VND - ongoing
- Closing of Maria Health Care Center (MHCC); relocating Sisters in need of skilled nursing care from MHCC (Baltimore, MD) to Stella Maris, Baltimore (Timonium), MD 06/2021.
- January 2024 a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was signed with Stella Maris Pangborn to an entire wing designated for the exclusive use of SSNDs, connecting with the Skilled Care Unit to keep all Sisters together on one floor with a balcony and access to the chapel.
- On October 20-29, 2025, the Care Transition Task Force, volunteers and the new Community Leadership Team (2025-2029) will move the 37 Sisters to their new home at Stella Maris in Timonium, MD.
- Seeking to sell Villa Assumpta, Baltimore, MD – ongoing
