Donor Spotlight Bernie and Mary Winker

Alumni of St. Alphonsus and St. Michael HS, Chicago, IL

Bernie and Mary Winker, of Huntley, IL, have been supporters of SSND for many years and have remembered SSND in their estate planning. Bernie proudly tells the story that he entered Kindergarten speaking only German. He credits Sister Imelda Mangold with teaching him to speak English and this began a lifelong love of learning at St. Alphonsus in Chicago. Mary also attended St. Alphonsus and then St. Michael's high school. Bernie explains their commitment to the Sisters:

"The dedication of the Sisters gave us a start to succeed. Our parents' religious beliefs in a dedicated group of sisters giving their children a fundamental basis in faith and education proved wise indeed. I went on from St Al's to a technical high school and graduated with a BSME from an engineering college. Mary followed grade school with 4 years at St. Michael Central high school, also with SSND teachers, graduating with high honors. Our 3 children have all earned bachelor and master degrees, and our two eldest grandchildren have earned their bachelor degrees, as well. Interestingly, of our four parents, the most formally educated among them went through the 10th gradealso taught by the SSND."
